Partnering with artist and naturalist, Tim Christensen, we will deeply notice New England landscapes in the Farnsworth's collection of American art. Through an examination of land formations and environmental details, participants will uncover ecological clues embedded in 18<sup>th</sup> and 19<sup>th</sup> century landscapes. We will consider symbiotic relationships found in nature and select our own natural objects to study in the studio. Practicing the technique of sgraffito, we will consider positive and negative space and texture as we classify and etch representations of our natural subjects into clay.
